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What We Do		
How does Southeast Financial Credit Union protect my personal information?	To protect your personal information from unauthorized access and use, we use security measures that comply with federal law. These measures include computer safeguards and secured files and buildings.	
How does Southeast Financial Credit Union collect my personal information?	We collect your personal information, for example, when you ◆ Open an account ◆ Apply for a loan ◆ Show your government-issued ID ◆ Seek advice about your investments We also collect your personal information from others, such as credit bureaus, affiliates, or other companies.	
Why can't I limit all sharing? Definitions		
Affiliates	Companies related by common ownership or control. They can be financial and non-financial companies. • Our affiliates include: • Financial companies such as: Members Financial Services and Southeast Resource Group.	
Nonaffiliates	Companies not related by common ownership or control. They can be financial and non-financial companies. • Nonaffiliates we share with can include insurance companies.	
Joint Marketing	A formal agreement between nonaffiliated financial companies that together mark financial products or services to you. ◆ Our joint marketing partners include insurance companies.	

Other Important Information

For Alaska, Illinois, Maryland and North Dakota Members. We will not share personal information with nonaffiliates either for them to market to you or for joint marketing - without your authorization.

For California Members. We will not share personal information with nonaffiliates either for them to market to you or for joint marketing - without your authorization. We will also limit our sharing of personal information about you with our affiliates to comply with all California privacy laws that apply to us.
