

2019 Southeast Financial Credit Union SCHOLARSHIP APPLICATION

The Program

Southeast Financial Credit Union has established a scholarship program to encourage and assist young people in furthering their education through post-secondary studies in university or vocational programs. Awards are granted without regard to race, color, creed, gender, disability or national origin.

Eligibility

The following criteria must be met to be eligible for the scholarship award:

- Applicant must be a member or dependent child of a member of the Credit Union. (A dependent child is defined as a natural or legally adopted child, a stepchild and/or a legal ward supported principally by the parent or guardian).
- Southeast Financial Credit Union Board of Directors, Scholarship Committee Members, employees and dependents are not eligible to participate.
- Applicant must be a high school senior planning to enroll in a full-time undergraduate course of study at an accredited two or four year college, university, or vocational/technical institute.
- Applicant must have earned a minimum 2.5 cumulative GPA on a 4.0 grade scale.
- Applicant must complete an official application and return it by February 1, 2019.
- Applications must be signed by the applicant and a school counselor/principal certifying the grade point average and attendance noted and should be accompanied by a certified copy of the applicant's transcript.
- All applications should be neatly prepared and legible.
- Applicant must submit an essay consisting of a minimum 250 words addressing the following topic: "Technology has changed in the financial industry over the last ten years. How have those advancements affected the way people view their finances, and how do you think those changes will affect you as an individual as you manage your finances on your own?"
- Applicant must submit a minimum of one letter of reference.
- Applicant must submit an official transcript of grades.

Selection Process:

The Southeast Financial Scholarship Committee will consider the following criteria to select the scholarship recipients:

- Applicant Essay (content, clarity, punctuation, grammar, spelling, etc.)
- Grade Point Average
- Community Involvement (school, church, employment)
- Attendance

Once the selection process has been completed, all applicants will be notified of the results. If selected, winners will be required to provide a final transcript verifying the completion of their high school requirements.

Scholarship Award

Southeast Financial will award two \$1,500 scholarships. These scholarships are for one year and are not renewable. \$750 will be awarded at fall semester/term enrollment, and \$750 will be awarded for the following spring semester/term. The student must successfully complete the first semester with a minimum GPA of 2.5 on a 4.0 scale to receive the \$750 scholarship for the spring semester/term.

Award checks will be made payable jointly to the educational institution and the award recipient.

All information submitted will be held confidential, and applicants will remain unknown to the Scholarship Committee. All decisions are final. Entries are the property of Southeast Financial Credit Union and cannot be returned. By entering, each winner consents to promotional use of his/her name and likeness without additional compensation.
